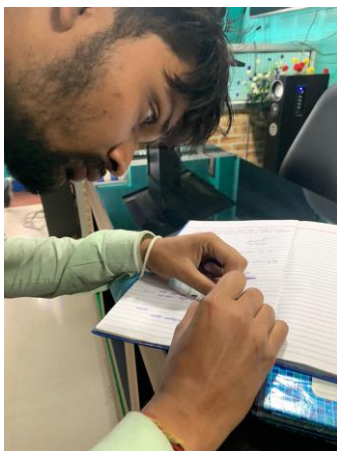

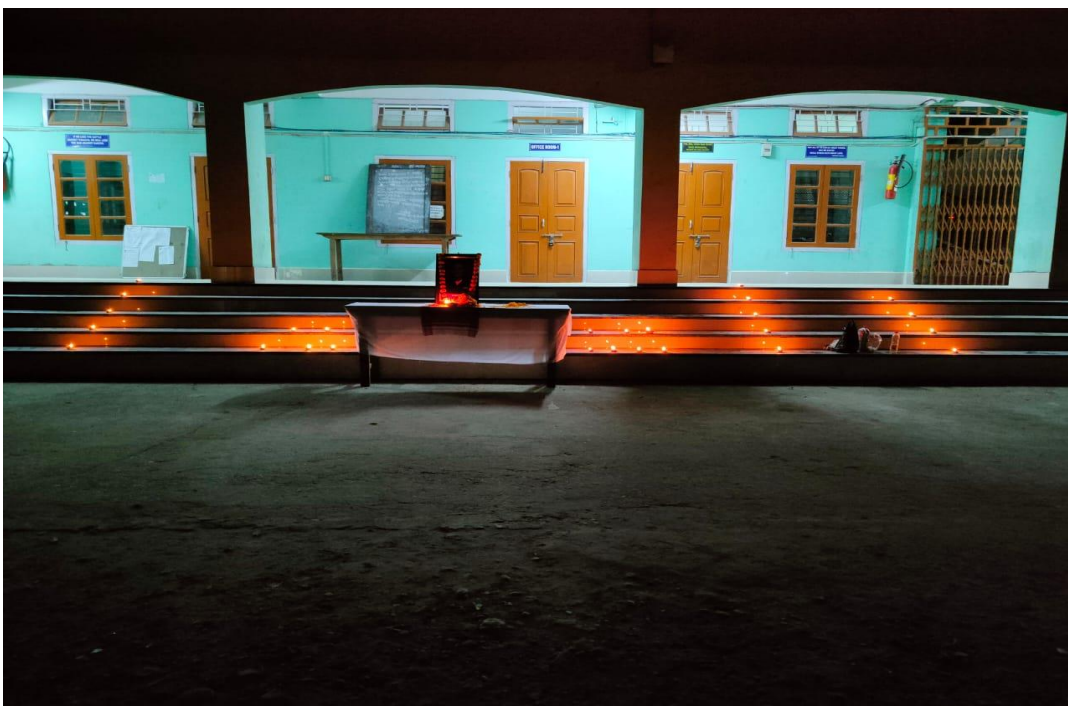
Black Day" (October 30)
