Our recent excursion to Kaziranga National Park for the VI semester regular students, as part of their SEC paper (code: **ZOO-SE-6014**) ; paper name: [**Wildlife Photography and Ecotourism**], was an enlightening and enriching experience.

Kaziranga National Park, located in the heart of Assam, India, is a world-renowned wildlife sanctuary celebrated for its exceptional biodiversity and conservation success. Spanning an area of approximately 430 square kilometers, Kaziranga is nestled on the floodplains of the Brahmaputra River, offering a mesmerizing landscape of tall elephant grass, dense tropical forests, and numerous water bodies. Established in 1905 as a reserve forest, Kaziranga was declared a National Park in 1974. In recognition of its outstanding universal value, it was designated a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1985. The park's most iconic inhabitants are the endangered Indian one-horned rhinoceroses, which constitute the largest population of this species in the world. Kaziranga is home to over 2,400 of these majestic animals, making it a crucial stronghold for their survival. Apart from rhinoceroses, Kaziranga boasts a remarkable array of wildlife, including the Bengal tiger, Asiatic elephant, wild water buffalo, and swamp deer. The park is one of the few places in India where all the members of the “Big Five” of Indian wildlife can be seen: the rhinoceros, elephant, tiger, swamp deer, and wild buffalo. Additionally, Kaziranga is a paradise for birdwatchers, with more than 450 species of birds, including migratory birds from Central Asia and Siberia. The park is divided into four main ranges: Central (Kohora), Western (Bagori), Eastern (Agoratoli), and Burapahar. Each range offers unique landscapes and wildlife viewing opportunities. Visitors can explore these ranges through guided jeep safaris or elephant rides, providing an intimate glimpse into the park's vibrant ecosystem. Kaziranga's success in wildlife conservation is largely attributed to the concerted efforts of park authorities and local communities. Anti-poaching measures, habitat management, and community involvement have been pivotal in preserving the park's rich biodiversity. The best time to visit

Kaziranga National Park is from November to April, when the weather is pleasant and wildlife sightings are more frequent. The nearest major city is Guwahati, about 220 kilometers away, which is well-connected by air, rail, and road. Jorhat, about 97 kilometers from the park, also serves as a convenient access point.

In essence, Kaziranga National Park is not only a sanctuary for some of the most endangered species on the planet but also a testament to successful conservation practices. Its enchanting landscapes and rich wildlife make it a must-visit destination for nature enthusiasts and wildlife lovers from around the globe.

The students were captivated by the park's rich biodiversity and cutting-edge conservation efforts, gaining invaluable insights into wildlife management and ecological preservation. This hands-on learning opportunity significantly enhanced their practical knowledge and understanding of ecological interrelationships, bridging the gap between theory and practice. Subsequently, each student meticulously prepared a self-excursion report, fulfilling the practical examination requirements and refining their research and reporting skills. This excursion proved to be an immensely beneficial component of their academic journey, providing both intellectual and practical enrichment.
