

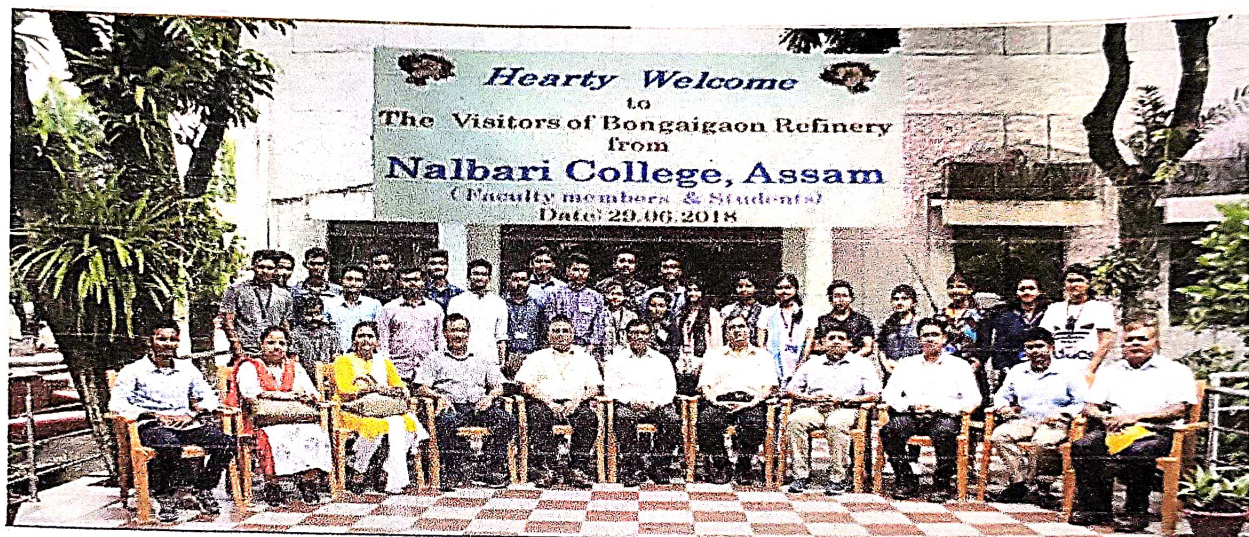

Introduction:

Department of chemistry of Nalbari college arranged one day industrial visit for 3rd and 5th semester degree students to Bongaigaon Refinery (BGR) dated 29th June, 2018.

Bongaigaon Refinery is an oil refinery and petrochemical complex located at Bongaigaon in Assam. Bongaigaon Refinery and Petrochemicals Limited (BRPL) has the distinction of being the first indigenous grass root refinery in the country integrated with a petrochemical complex at one location. In March 25, 2009 BRPL merged with Indian Oil Corporation Limited (IOCL) to become its eighth largest refinery and came to be known as Bongaigaon Refinery (BGR). The company has its registered office and production facilities at Dhaligaon in Chirang district inside of Bongaigaon urban area of Assam in North-East India.

The major products from the refinery are - LPG, MS, Naphtha, ATF, SKO, HSD, LDO, LSHS, LVFO, RPC, CPC, DMT, and PSF.

Visit Report:

Students of 3rd and 5th semester of chemistry department of Nalbari college, along with the professors visited Bongaigaon Refinery on 29th June, 2018. A total of 40 students and the professors assembled at 5:45 am. in the college campus and left the campus at 6:15 am. in a bus that was arranged for the occasion. We were advised to wear shoes and not to bring mobiles, cameras, matchbox etc. inside the BGR campus.

After few hours of travelling, at about 8:15 am, we drank tea in a hotel and continued our journey. We reached our destination by 9:30 am. and we were given a warm welcome.

As we reached, one of the faculty members of BGR received us at the entrance and were taken to the dining hall and breakfast was served. After the breakfast, we were taken to the learning section. In the learning section there were seats for us along with a note book and a pen. The programme was

started with the theme song of BGR. We stood up during the theme song. After that one of the faculty members of BGR introduced each of the faculty members who were present and requested to take their seats. Then another faculty member gave a power point presentation about BGR in brief. We noted down important things on our notebooks.

After that, we were taken in a bus with a guide to show different working sides of the refinery. They told us about two new projects which were going to complete. One of them was 'indmax' which means the maximisation of indane. This is such a huge project. The campus is very big. We were taken to the

ecological park which is situated inside the BGR. The eco park is so beautiful and various plants are there. There is a pond surrounding the park, through which the storm water drains of the plant are routed for final discharge.

After that, we came back and we were taken to the dining hall and lunch was served. After the meal, we again seated in the learning section where, one of the faculty members of BGR told us about the apprentice portal and other scopes of BGR. At the end, two of our professors namely, HOD Mr. Madan Ch. Medhi Sir and Dr. Naba Deka sir gave their remarks on this industrial visit. They captured photos with us. After all, their hospitality to the Nalbari college students and faculty members was very good. We left the place at about 2:30 pm. and our visit drew to an end at 5:30 pm.

I would like to express my gratitude to all of our professors for organising
