This memorandum is executed on 15th of October, 2019 at Nalbari, Assam, between Department of Sanskrit, Nalbari College, Nalbari and Kamrup Sanskrit Sanjivani Sabha, Nalbari, Assam. The Department of Sanskrit, Nalbari College, Nalbari is First Party here and Kamrup Sanskrit Sanjivani Sabha, Nalbari, Assam is the Second Party.

Preamble

Nalbari College is one of the premier colleges of Assam. It was established in preindependent era on 4th of July 1945. It has its campus at Majdia, Nalbari. The college has taken a pioneering role in shaping and promoting higher education in the entire lower Brahmaputra Valley. It has been maintaining its reputation as a centre for quality education in higher education in both Arts and Science streams. In the beginning, the college was affiliated to the University of Calcutta, but in 1948, when Gauhati University was established, it came under the academic jurisdiction of the latter. The college has generated talents for pursuit of truth, creation and dissemination of knowledge. It has celebrated its Diamond Jubilee in the year 2020. Again, the Department of Sanskrit was established in 1945 and the major course was introduced in 1971. The founder HoD of the Department was Lakshi Kanta Tripathi. Veteran Sanskrit scholar like Mukunda Madhava Sharma, Bhagawan Goswami, Jamini Kanta Sharma etc. graced the Department. It has a consistent record of brilliant result. The student of this Department clinched the laurel of best Graduate of Gauhati University for three times.

Kamrup Sanskrit Sanjivani Sabha (KSSS) was established in 1913 at Nalbari, Assam for the study and preservation of the rich heritage of India with its cultural ingredients. In 2013, it has completed its 100 years' celebration with pomp and gay. It is a self-governing secular society of education and culture registered vide No. 77 of 1960-61 under the Registration of Society Act. XXI of 1860. The prime objectives of the KSSS were to expand the study of Sanskrit Language alongwith preservation of Manuscripts (MSS) and old rare Books. The then Sanskrit scholars had given emphasis on collection and preservation of MSS that were lying in different parts of ancient Kamrup (i.e. the old name of Assam was *Kamarupa*). As a result, KSSS had become a storehouse of many valuable MSS. Presently, the Library of KSSS has about 1500 MSS at its disposal.


Objectives

The MoU leads to undertake several activities for the benefit of both the institutions. Students of the Department of Sanskrit, Nalbari College may visit to attend Lecture, Talk, Workshop, Field Study, Session, Experimental Learning at Kamrup Sanskrit Sanjivani Sabha, Nalbari, Assam in consultation with both the parties at convenient time. Academic Programmes like Siminars/Symposia/Workshop, Exhibition etc. may be jointly organised by quality sharing of resources of both the Parties. Training camp and Social activities like Spoken Sanskrit Residential Camp, Samskrit Divasa etc. can be organised. For the development of Sanskrit learning, both the Parties may come forward to contribute in the field of research, traditional knowledge System, Translation, Deciphering the Manuscripts, Preservation and Conservation work of Manuscripts and Old Books, Archeology and other academic items.

Dispute Settlement/Arbitration

Except the provisions of this MoU, no use of the name, symbols, signs of one institution shall be used by the other. The agreement shall become effective from the date of its signing and continue thereafter for 5 years subject to revision or modification by mutual agreement and unless terminated by either of the two Parties hereto. Termination by one Institution shall be effected by giving the other institution at least 90 days in advance by written notices of termination. Either Party may request in writing a revision, variation or amendment of the MoU. Any such revision, variation of amendment shall come into force on such date as may be determined by the Parties. The cost of the activities may be funded as mutually determined subject to the availability of fund of the Institutions.

Both the parties agree to the above terms and conditions in principle subject to the completion of such other formalities required by the rules governing both the institutions. This MoU will come into effect from the date it is signed.


