This memorandum of understanding is made and executed on 4th February, 2022 for 05 years from 4th February, 2022 to 03th February, 2027 between Nalbari college, P.O. Nalbari, Dist. Nalbari, Assam, India, PIN - 781335 and North Eastern Society for Advancement of Human Resource Kahilipara, Guwahati – 781019, Assam.

Preamble

Nalbari College, Nalbari is one of the premier higher educational institutions in Assam. The institution is established in pre-independent India on 4th July 1945. From its establishment onwards, the college has taken a pioneering role in shaping and promoting higher education in the entire lower Brahmaputra valley. Beginning with a modest number of only 28 students, today it has a sizable strength of about 4420 students (including Higher Secondary programme). It is a multi-streamed co-educational institution imparting education right from Higher Secondary to PG level.
