This memorandum of understanding is made and executed on 9/8/22 for 05 years from 9/8/22 to 8/8/27 between the, Nalbari college, P.O. Nalbari, Dist. Nalbari, Assam, India, PIN - 781335 and the Nabarun NGO, Dist. - Nalbari, Assam, India, PIN - 781334.

Preamble

Nalbari College, Nalbari is one of the premier higher educational institutions in Assam. The institution is established in pre-independent India on 4th July 1945. From its establishment onwards, the college has taken a pioneering role in shaping and promoting higher education in the entire lower Brahmaputra valley. This is one of the premier college that consistently demonstrated excellence in academic and research pursuits.

Nabarun NGO is a prominent sports club based in the Nalbari District, established in 1975. Since its inception, the club has been dedicated to promoting sports activities among the youth of the district, playing a crucial role in nurturing and developing local talent.

Nalbari College, Nalbari and Nabarun NGO, Nalbari have joined forces to promote sports activities among the students of Nalbari College. This collaborative effort aims to enhance the physical fitness and sports skills of the students, encouraging greater participation in various sports disciplines and fostering a culture of athletic excellence in the college community.

Nalbari College, Nalbari, and Nabarun NGO, Nalbari hereinafter collectively referred to as the parties/institutions, and individually as party/institution.

Objectives

The objective of the Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between Nalbari College and Nabarun NGO focuses on several key goals:

1. To develop and upgrade sports facilities and infrastructure within Nalbari College to provide students with access to high-quality training environments.
2. To offer professional coaching and training programs for students, leveraging the expertise of Nabarun Sports Club to improve students' skills in various sports disciplines.
3. To organize inter-college and inter-district sports events, tournaments, and competitions to foster a competitive spirit and provide a platform for students to showcase their talents.
4. To motivate and encourage students to actively participate in sports activities, emphasizing the importance of physical fitness and its role in overall development.

5. To identify talented athletes among the student population and provide them with specialized training and support to help them achieve higher levels of performance.
6. To involve the local community in sports activities and create opportunities for community members to engage with and support college sports programs.

There will be no financial obligations on both parties under this agreement.

General Coordinators:

Each party shall designate an administrative office/department to oversee and facilitate the implementation of any agreements arising out of this MoU.

Intellectual Property Rights:

Nalbari College, Nalbari and Nabarun NGO, Nalbari agree to respect each other's right to intellectual property. Further, all rights linked to ideas, inventions, and patents generated during the MoU shall remain the common intellectual property of the parties. The parties shall not pass on or give usage rights of such property to any third party without the consent of the other party.


Dispute Settlement:


In the event of any dispute or differences arising under this agreement, the parties shall try to discuss and arrive at an amicable resolution thereof. If the parties fail to arrive at an amicable resolution within (thirty) 30 days of the dispute having arisen, the matter shall be referred to arbitration by a single arbitrator appointed under the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996. The arbitral proceedings shall be held in Guwahati and the language of arbitration shall be English. The parties agree that the decision of the arbitrator shall be final and binding on the parties. The arbitration tribunal shall also decide on the costs of the arbitration procedure.

This MoU shall be constructed as a statement of purpose to promote a genuine and mutually beneficial collaboration between the parties. Nothing in this MoU shall be constructed to create a legal relationship between the parties.

This MoU shall come into force from the date of its signatures and shall remain valid for 05 years. This MoU may be modified/ renewed, or extended with the mutual written consent of the parties.


