

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This memorandum of understanding is made and executed on 4th February, 2022 for 05 years from 4th February, 2022 to 03th February, 2027 between Nalbari college, P.O. Nalbari, Dist. Nalbari, Assam, India, PIN - 781335 and North Eastern Society for Advancement of Human Resource Kahilipara, Guwahati – 781019, Assam.

Preamble

Nalbari College, Nalbari is one of the premier higher educational institutions in Assam. The institution is established in pre-independent India on 4th July 1945. From its establishment onwards, the college has taken a pioneering role in shaping and promoting higher education in the entire lower Brahmaputra valley. Beginning with a modest number of only 28 students, today it has a sizable strength of about 4420 students (including Higher Secondary programme). It is a multi-streamed co-educational institution imparting education right from Higher Secondary to PG level.

North Eastern Society for Advancement of Human Resource (NESAHR), Kahilipara, Guwahati has established in the year 2001 and introduce itself as an NGO committed towards the management of green environment with proper waste disposal and its management. NESAHR is registered under Society Registration Act XXI of 1860. The organization has worked with multiple stakeholders: governmental bodies, private sector, and other NGOs to create a platform towards sustainable green environment.

Both parties have tremendous potential in accelerating ground level ecofriendly community-based work. Nalbari College is committed to fostering environmental sustainability and promoting community engagement initiatives. Organizing various ecofriendly community works alongside providing quality education is a commendable aspect of Nalbari College. Accordingly, NESAHR is responsible for the management of waste and dedicated to enhancing waste management practices and fostering collaborations with educational institutions. Both parties recognize the importance of implementing sustainable waste management practices to mitigate environmental pollution and promote public health, and acknowledge the potential benefits of mutual cooperation in the field of waste management, including knowledge sharing, resource optimization, and community outreach.

Nalbari College, Nalbari and NESAHR, Kahilipara, Guwahati hereinafter collectively referred to as the parties/organizations, and individually as party/organization.

Objectives

1. Collaborate to implement sustainable waste disposal/management practices, with a focus on reducing waste generation, promoting recycling and composting, and minimizing landfill disposal.
2. Fostering joint research projects and initiatives aimed at developing innovative waste management technologies, methodologies, and solutions that are environmentally friendly, cost-effective, and scalable.
3. Development and implementation of educational programs, workshops, and awareness campaigns in collaboration with local communities to promote waste reduction, segregation, and responsible disposal practices.
4. To Provide training and capacity-building programs for students, and community members on waste management best practices, including waste segregation, collection, transportation, and treatment.

General Coordinators:

Each party shall designate an administrative office/department to oversee and facilitate the implementation of any agreements arising out of this Memorandum of Understanding (MoU).

Dispute Settlement:

In the event of any dispute or differences arising under this agreement, the parties shall try to discuss and arrive at an amicable resolution thereof. If the parties fail to arrive at an amicable resolution within (thirty) 30 days of the dispute having arisen, the matter shall be referred to arbitration by a single arbitrator appointed under the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996. The arbitral proceedings shall be held in Guwahati and the language of arbitration shall be English. The parties agree that the decision of the arbitrator shall be final and binding on the parties. The arbitration tribunal shall also decide on the costs of the arbitration procedure.

This MoU shall be constructed as a statement of purpose to promote a genuine and mutually beneficial collaboration between the parties. Nothing in this MoU shall be constructed to create a legal relationship between the parties.


This MoU shall come into force from the date of its signatures and shall remain valid for 05 years. This MoU may be modified/ renewed, or extended with the mutual written consent of the parties.



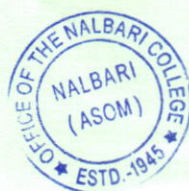
