

Memorandum of Understanding

This memorandum of understanding is made and executed on 15/12/21 for 05 years from 15/12/21 to 14/12/26 between the Nalbari college, P.O. Nalbari, Dist. Nalbari, Assam, India, PIN - 781335 and the Nalbari Netralaya, Nalbari, Assam, India, PIN – 781335.

Preamble

Nalbari College, Nalbari is one of the premier higher educational institutions in Assam. The institution is established in pre-independent India on 4th July 1945. From its establishment onwards, the college has taken a pioneering role in shaping and promoting higher education in the entire lower Brahmaputra valley. This is one of the premier colleges that consistently demonstrated excellence in academic and research pursuits.

Nalbari Netralaya, a premier Eye Hospital of North East India was started in 2021. Since its inception, Nalbari Netralaya aims to serve the people of the region at their door steps by various outreach program. The Hospital is committed to continue its mission for vision to all class of people.

The Nalbari College and Nalbari Netralaya signifies a collaborative effort aimed at benefiting the community through education and healthcare services.

Nalbari College, Nalbari, and Nalbari Netralaya, Nalbari hereinafter collectively referred to as the parties/institutions, and individually as party/institution.

Objectives

The key objectives of this MoU may include:

1. Facilitating the exchange of knowledge, expertise, and resources between Nalbari College and Nalbari Netralaya, promoting mutual learning and development.
2. Collaborating on skill development programs aimed at enhancing the capabilities of students, healthcare professionals, and staff members in both institutions.
3. Research Collaboration: Undertaking joint research projects in areas of mutual interest, such as healthcare innovation, public health, and community development.
4. Educational Outreach: Organizing outreach programs to raise awareness about healthcare issues, preventive measures, and educational opportunities within the community.
5. Internship and Training Programs: Providing internship and training opportunities for college students interested in healthcare professions, fostering practical learning experiences and career development.
6. Community Health Initiatives: Implementing community health initiatives to address local healthcare needs, such as medical camps, health screenings, and health education programs.
7. Resource Sharing: Sharing facilities, equipment, and infrastructure to optimize resources and improve service delivery in both educational and healthcare domains.

There will be no financial obligations on both parties under this agreement.

General Coordinators:

Each party shall designate an administrative office/department to oversee and facilitate the implementation of any agreements arising out of this MoU.

Intellectual Property Rights:

Nalbari College, Nalbari and Nalbari Netralaya, Nalbari agree to respect each other's right to intellectual property. Further, all rights linked to ideas, inventions, and patents generated during the MoU shall remain the common intellectual property of the parties. The parties shall not pass on or give usage rights of such property to any third party without the consent of the other party.

Dispute Settlement:

In the event of any dispute or differences arising under this agreement, the parties shall try to discuss and arrive at an amicable resolution thereof. If the parties fail to arrive at an amicable resolution within (thirty) 30 days of the dispute having arisen, the matter shall be referred to arbitration by a single arbitrator appointed under the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996. The arbitral proceedings shall be held in Guwahati and the language of arbitration shall be English. The parties agree that the decision of the arbitrator shall be final and binding on the parties. The arbitration tribunal shall also decide on the costs of the arbitration procedure.

This MoU shall be constructed as a statement of purpose to promote a genuine and mutually beneficial collaboration between the parties. Nothing in this MoU shall be constructed to create a legal relationship between the parties.

This MoU shall come into force from the date of its signatures and shall remain valid for 05 years. This MoU may be modified/ renewed, or extended with the mutual written consent of the parties.
